It revolved around the Gateway




production of Mooseltoe and aligned the learnings in the show with the teachings in school. Pre show, at show and post show learning activities took place to support this grant.

What We Do SCEF is an independent, not-for-profit

organization committed to improving educational opportunities for all students in the South Country School District by:

- Giving education grants (upwards of \$40,000 for the 2014 grant cycle)
- Supporting our cultural and educational committees: Becker/Gambles Music Fund, Martin Luther King Foundation and Students 4 Art
- Partnering with the Boys and Girls Club and Knapp/Swezey Foundation for the 5th grade YMCA Swim Program
- Offering professional development grants

What We Support SCEF is both proud and honored to support the South Country Central School District's multi-year Literacy Improvement through Technology Initiative. This initiative is designed to prepare students for participation in a knowledge-based society by successfully meeting the increased reading, writing, and critical thinking demands required in this 21st Century. At the core of this initiative are three vital building blocks: specialized teacher training, personalized instruction through adaptive software, and a comprehensive research-based reading program designed to maximize student development.

SCEF, with our community's support and funding, provided a grant to enable the purchase of "COWS" or com

puters on wheels. The COWs provide the capability of this program to be portable from classroom to classroom and from school to school to optimize this initiative's reach



to as many students as possible. The following quote from Dr. Joseph Giani, Superintendent of Schools, sums up the impact we have made:

"We are both excited and grateful for SCEF's generous donation and

support of our Literacy Improvement through Technology Initiative. Their donation supported the purchase of Computers on Wheels (COWS) allowing us to deliver research based reading intervention programs to more students than our current technology could support."

Karen Rowley, a member of the SCEF Community Advisory Council and the Becker/Gambles Music Fund passed away in April, 2013. Karen asked that donations be sent to the SCEF music fund. Over the past year, dozens of donations were received benefitting our summer music

lessons, master classes and more.

In November 2014 Steve Rowley, Karen's son, made a donation to the Becker/Gambles Music Fund of \$10,000 in honor of his mother, folllowing her wishes.

Karen's legacy lives on as we use her very generous donation to continue to enrich the music education of the grateful students of the South Country School District.
